FARAGO, a new Los Angeles project space, housed in a unique triad of storefronts at the base of the Tower Theatre, is pleased to announce its inaugural exhibition of works on paper by Ben Berlow.

Ben Berlow is an artist who for the past decade has been creating both discrete and serial works on paper that uniformly explore notions of shape, line, and color while retaining their own unique sense of formulation and wit. Deployed on a variety of found paper surfaces—including book leaves—the twenty-nine works that comprise this show are a unique grouping, each varying between the years 2003-2013.

Ben Berlow was born in Los Angeles, California in 1980 and lives and works in Brooklyn, New York. He has been included in group shows at David Zwirner (New York), Marlborough Chelsea (New York) and James Fuentes LLC (New York) amongst others. Berlow has had three solo exhibitions at New York's Rawson Projects, as well as solo exhibitions at Callicoon Fine Arts (New York), Jack Hanley Gallery (New York), Studio Miko (New York) and Parade (London).
